We engineer, build and operate a fully IP-based, carrier class fiber & wireless network from core to edge for high reliability and speed to the end-user.




- Form a Broadband Task Force Look for Broadband Project Champions

EASTERN ILLINI ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE

- Nextlink builds Fiber Network between Substations
- Nextlink will build Monopoles at Substations
- EIEC can mount AMR equipment on the monopoles
- Nextlink provides last mile connectivity to consumers/businesses with fixed wireless
- Initial rollout 500/100 Mbps, future upgrade to 1 Gbps
